ANIMAL SERVICES ADVISORY BOARD - Advises the City Council and Staff on matters relating to the City's Animal Services Division and its operations and is specifically charged with ensuring the City complies with State law requirements relating to the operation of animal shelters; 7 members, including 1 licensed veterinarian, 1 representative from an animal welfare organization, 1 municipal official, 1 person whose duties include the daily operation of an animal shelter and 3 additional members that are Temple residents; Chair to be appointed annually by City Council; 3 year terms; Meetings held 2nd Monday of every other month, 11:00 am, Animal Services Facility (Res. No. 2003-3589-R) [Board Members](#)

BUILDING & STANDARDS COMMISSION - Hears and determines cases concerning alleged violations of City ordinances related to building codes, including the minimum housing code; conditions covered by accumulation of matter that creates unsanitary and unhealthy conditions; functions of the Historic Preservation ordinance; and serves as a screening committee for the rental rehabilitation and the owner-occupied housing rehabilitation program; 5 regular members and 4 alternate members; 2 year terms; Meetings held 1st Monday of each month, 2:00 p.m., City Council Chambers. (Ord. 2060, under authority of Chapter 54, Subchapter C, Local Govt. Code) [Board Members](#)

BUILDING BOARD OF APPEALS - Submits recommendations to the Council for improvements and revisions to the Standard Building Code, Mechanical Code, One and Two Family Dwelling Code, Plumbing Code, Gas Code and Fire Prevention Code as it deems necessary and proper in the light of the development of new materials, methods or techniques and hears appeals to these Codes; 9 members, to include 2 architects or engineers, 2 master plumbers, 2 from building industry, including general contractor engineer or other, 1 from mechanical or air conditioning trade, and 2 at large; 4 year terms; Meetings are conducted on a called basis, within 10 days after notice of appeal has been filed. CIVIL SERVICE COMMISSION - Makes rules and regulations for administering the personnel system within the Fire and Police Departments, hears and rules on appeals of disciplinary actions from the Fire and Police Departments, establishes qualifications and rules of conduct for Fire and Police personnel; 3 members who must be U.S. citizen, a resident of municipality for more than three years, over 25 years of age and not have held a public office within the preceding three years; 3 year terms; Meetings conducted on a called basis. COMMUNITY SERVICES ADVISORY BOARD - Assesses public service needs in the community; annually requests proposals from public service agencies to meet identified needs; recommends funding levels to the Council from the CDBG annual budget; monitors the agencies receiving CDBG funds to evaluate their performance and proper utilization of funds; 9 members, all residents of Bell County, with City Manager serving as ex-officio member; 3 year terms; Regular meetings from October through May, with special meetings as needed. DEVELOPMENT STANDARDS ADVISORY BOARD – Advises the City Council and Planning & Zoning Commission on matters relating to the Subdivision Ordinance, City’s standard construction details, and related development standards and regulations; 9 members, 5 to be residents of City or ETJ or own or be employed by a business that has an office within the City; 7 of 9 positions are to be represented from civil engineering, general construction, utility construction, street construction, real estate, banking, insurance, land development, architecture, homebuilding or surveying professions; 3 year terms; Meetings held on called basis. ELECTRICAL BOARD - Hears and rules on appeals of application of the Electrical Code; provides recommendations for changes and additions to the Code; reviews and upgrades license examinations; 7 members, including 2 master electricians, 1 journeyman electrician, 1 representative from TXU Electric Co., 1 representative from construction industry, 1 architect, engineer or insurance industry representative, and 1 attorney; 3 year terms; Meetings held on called basis. LIBRARY BOARD - Advise the Council on the operation and maintenance of the Library; 9 members, all residents of City; 3 year terms; Meetings held 3rd Tuesday of each quarter at Noon in the Library Board Room - (City Charter, Section 3.25) [Board Members](#)

NORTH CENTRAL TEMPLE NEIGHBORHOOD CODE ENFORCEMENT BOARD – Has quasi-judicial enforcement of City Ordinances relating to building and other City codes, as delegated under Ordinance 2007-4126, over an area generally bounded by Adams Avenue on the south, North 3rd on the east, Oakland Avenue on the north and the BNSF property to the west; 5 regular members and 2 alternate members, all to be adult residents of the geographical area for which the board is responsible; 3 year terms; Meetings held on called basis. PARKS & LEISURE SERVICES ADVISORY BOARD - Advises the City Council and the Director of Parks & Leisure Services on matters relating to the City's parks, recreational programs, Sammons Golf Course, Frank W. PLANNING & ZONING COMMISSION - Serves in an advisory capacity to City Council by making recommendations on land use proposals including zoning changes, subdivision plats, and annexations; works with City Staff, the community, and the Council in the development and updating of the Comprehensive Plan and the Area Plans for the City, as well as the Capital Improvement Program for community facilities; 9 members, all residents of City; 3 year terms; Meetings are held 1st & 3rd Mondays of each month, 5:00 p.m., City Council Chambers (Ord. 149, Ord. 2030) [Board Members](#)

REINVESTMENT ZONE NUMBER ONE - The board of directors makes recommendations to the City Council concerning the administration of the Zone; exercise powers necessary to implement the project plan which is delegated by ordinance of the Council; 15 directors, 9 appointed by the City Council and 1 director from each taxing entity within the Zone (TC, TISD, BISD, Troy ISD, Bell County, Elm Creek Water Shed), with Chairman appointed by Council each year in December; Members must be qualified voter of the municipality or at least 18 years of age and own real property in the Zone, whether or not the individual resides in the municipality; 2 year terms; Meetings are held the 4th Wednesday of each month, 7:00 a.m., Staff Conference Room. TEMPLE ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION - Non-profit corporation that coordinates efforts in order to ensure optimal economic development within the City; 15 directors, all appointed by City Council, including 4 representatives from Temple Chamber of Commerce Board, 1 from Bioscience District Board, 1 from RZ No. 1 Board, 5 at-large, and 4 standing appointments to include the Mayor, 1 City Council representative, City Manager, and RZ No. 1 Chair; 3 year terms; Meetings are held the 3rd Tuesday of each month, 10:00 p.m. , TEDC Board Room. TEMPLE PUBLIC SAFETY ADVISORY BOARD - Advises the Council on matters of law enforcement, fire, emergency medical service, communications and emergency management; 15 members, all residents of City; 3 year terms; Meetings held the 2nd Tuesday of each month at 5:30 p.m., Temple Police Department (Res. 94-641-R) [Board Members](#)

TRANSIT ADVISORY COMMITTEE – Reviews operations of Temple Transit System and makes suggestions for service enhancements; makes advisory policy recommendations to the City Council; attends public hearings regarding system changes conducted by the contractor and reports findings to City Council and Hill Country Transit District Board of Directors; 7 members, all residents of City, to include 1 elderly member, not disabled, 1 disabled member, and 3 members that are not program participants but represent health, education or business community; 2 year terms; Meetings held the 2nd Thursday of every other month at 2:00 p.m., Library Board Room. TREE BOARD – Develops public awareness and education programs relating to trees; promotes Arbor Day; develops and updates 5-year plan for planting trees on City property; advises Parks and Leisure Services on issues relating to planting or maintenance of trees and other landscaping on City property. 5 members – 1 member of Parks and Leisure Services Advisory Board, 1 member of Keep Temple Beautiful, Inc. Board of Directors, 1 member of Planning and Zoning Commission, 1 member of Blackland Research and Extension Center, and 1 member at-large; Meetings held at least 4 times per year.
